Security and Personal Safety is Priority at GCC

A letter was recently sent home to update you on security measures already in place here at GCC and on the Geneva Campus. The safety of children, staff and families will always be a high priority with GCC and the Geneva Presbyterian Church. If you did not receive a letter please contact Mrs. Sherry, GCC Director to receive a copy. Please make sure that GCC has updated information regarding changes to your **phone numbers, address and updates or changes of those persons who are able to pick up your child from GCC.** Please have anyone other than the parent who picks up your child bring their photo ID with them when picking up your child. We are also requesting if there is a change of who is picking up your child that you notify the GCC office by phone and preferably in writing.

Just a reminder that GCC closes at 6:30 p.m. We understand that there may be an emergency that keeps you from arriving on time, please call GCC at 949 581-2200 to inform us if you are going to be late. A late fee may be charged, please refer to the Parent Handbook page 11. The fee is \$5.00 for the first 15 minutes late and \$1.00 per minute thereafter. This charge will be added for payment on your next statement. A closing staff member may also contact you if your child has stayed longer than their normal pick up time as we have several children whose families share the pick-up responsibility. Thank you for supporting our staff as they want to make sure that your child is safe and secure.
