Chancy & Bruce visit GCC April 19 and offer: The School Readiness Developmental Profile. This screening assesses the child's ability to process information in several areas of development including: Fine/Gross Motor, Visual Memory/Discrimination, Auditory Memory/Discrimination Receptive/Expressive Language, Reasoning Comprehension and Social-Emotional Maturity regarding entrance to kindergarten. Just a reminder: May 4, Southern California Sensory Screening Inc. will be at GCC to conduct an educational health assessment for children 3 years and older. SCSS has specialized in this field since 1980 and are cleared through the state of Cal.
