SCSS will provide an Educational Health Assessment here at GCC on Tuesday, February 13th starting at 9:00 A.M. This program is provided for children 3 years and older. The four screenings that are available are: Hearing, Vision, Speech/Language and Gross/Fine Motor. Any two screenings are \$35 and all four screenings are \$40. All assessments are conducted here at GCC.
